There were not any suitable dates remaining for the summer of 2024 so this cruise has been postponed until 2025. We have a tentative reserved date of June 1, 2025. Gary Bruebaker is a member of Mustangs West and the other PCMC and he is trying to get a group of 30-50 people from Puget Sound area Mustang clubs that would be interested in cruising to Salem, OR to view a private car collection called Brothers Car Collection.

The cost to tour the massive museum (one source called it the greatest collection of muscle cars) is \$20.00 per person. This gives you access for 3.5 hrs to tour the museum as you like. We would be the only group in the museum that afternoon. All the money collected is donated to charities. The tour is only available on Sunday afternoons. The museum is not open to the general public.

Red, Story #2

Even though I have four other Mustangs in the yard I will have to highlight my red SVO again.

You want a story about a trip? Well here it is.

I saw a notice that there was a new road course in the Ozarks of Missouri and they were doing open track time. I paid my \$450 and spent the next three months finding places I wanted to go.

I was supposed to leave on Monday May 20 but I was still waiting for parts for the speedo. I hit the road about noon on the 21st.

First stop was Crazy Horse and Rushmore. Now with these being national monuments you would think there would be signs everywhere. But no, the only one for Crazy Horse is the gate going to the parking lot. Since I was a day and a half late I couldn't take the trip to the work. Rushmore is 17 miles away but I drove around those mountains for two hours and never found it.



The next day I accidentally found the Corn Palace. Look it up, most interesting.

On Saturday the 25th I pulled into the Ozarks. I went to the track and found out the track time was for the MCA National. Sunday was my day on the track. I had never been on a race track before. I followed a

couple instructors and learned what my car, tires, and I could do. I had four ½ hour sessions. After that the guy that designed, built and owned the track took me out for a

few laps in his 700hp GT500. I told my neurologist I made my own dopamine! (Parkinson's reference) When I crossed into Montana, I blew out the exhaust manifold gasket. I didn't get to change it until the day after the track. I also almost lost all four bolts on the rear u-joint flange. I guess you can't keep using the same bolts over and over because they stretch. I will replace them all.

The next stop was in Tipp City Ohio. The Halderman Barn. You can see the horse from the top of the hill. No one was there so I thought I could get picture so I could say I'd been there. From around



the corner a voice says” How're you doing?? Turned out to be Gails daughter. I was there for way more than an hour. We talked about how modest he was, the kids didn't even know what he did. He was dad and dad did this. I put my hand on Jon Chlor's 76 Cobra II.

That afternoon I was at LeClair Iowa where the original Antique Archaeology store is.

From there it was on to Carlisle PA and the big All Ford Swap Meet. When I was a kid I wanted to go to this every year. There were lots of unicorns, like in '69 a friend went with a NASCAR 427 side oiler block, and another friend had a Holman-Moody aluminum low rise dual quad intake. This is the place where guys from the entire country went to sell parts from their projects or found that one elusive part. But now it is just a car show. Granted, represented by Galaxy, Fairlane, Falcon, Ranchero, Lots of Mustangs, and Pinto clubs. I never found Jon Chlor either.



The next days travel put me accidentally in front of Bristol racetrack.



Last stop was The Tail of the Dragon in the Tennessee hills. US highway 129. 318 curves in 11 miles. Notice in the picture how smooth the pavement is. They finished repaving the entire road the day before I was there. So smooth and so sticky. After running Ozarks I was fearless cranking into the hairpins and driving as hard as I could not a squeak from the tires. See tire sidebar below. Went down and up twice.

The next day it was time to turn home. I wanted to stop at the Antique Archaeology in Memphis but never found it. I spent most of the highway cruising between 80 and 90mph.

All of a sudden the oil pressure was 0. I pulled off and checked it, it was dry. I had checked it this morning and it was OK. The two quarts I had got me to a truck stop. I filled it and went on. After about 50 miles the pressure was 0 and the stick was dry. Found out that the gasket under the turbo to the oil drain was bad. I found a guy in one of the small towns that verified the problem and tightened the flange. I was off again.

Red was running excellent on the Highway but when I got into stop and go it had a real problem accelerating. I am pretty sure the low pressure pump in the fuel tank died. That might have been my problem all along. I gave up in Laramie Wyoming because there were mountains to climb and I didn't want to be stranded on the side of the highway. Cost me \$950 to ship it to the parking lot on 128th and \$150 for a 30 hour bus ride.

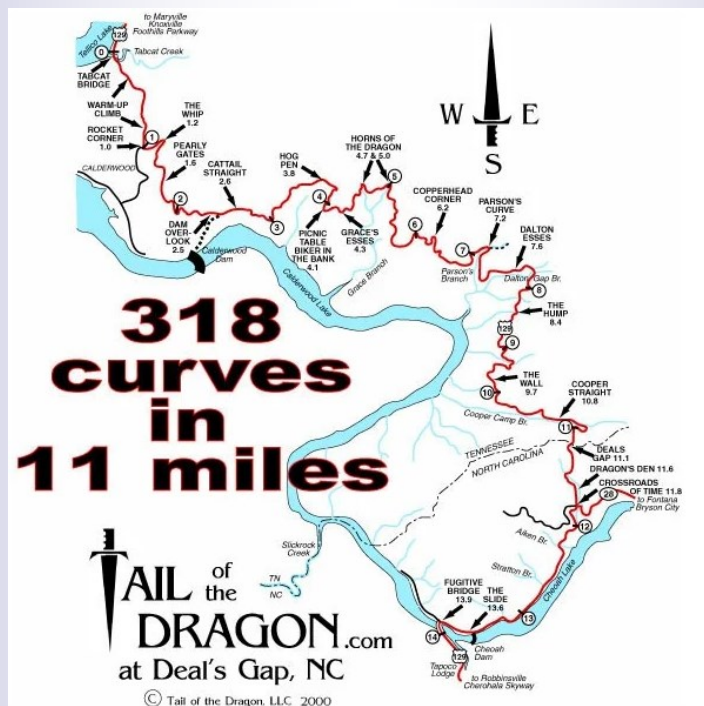


Start mileage 81481

I figure this will be my last epic journey and I did it alone.

Tire Sidebar

Tracks have a rule that you can't be on tires that are more than five years old. The ones on Red were 10, I put them on for Vegas. The ones on Silver were 30 and were cracked and dry. I replaced the ones on Silver using the original wheels. I bought B.F. Goodrich G-Force Comp II. If you are looking for new tires they are amazing.

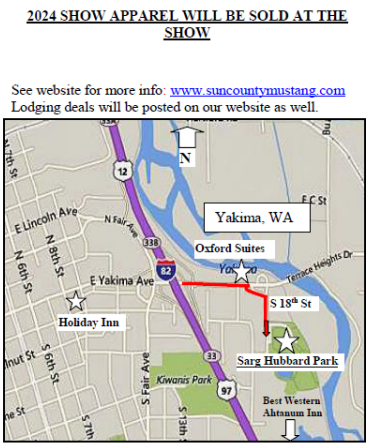


